New Library Project Update

While the library project remains in the top ten city council goals, the defeat of Measure N in November is causing the city to take a whole new look at the process. Everything is up for discussion and change including site and delivery of library services (one library or two). If you were an opponent of the measure, this is your opportunity to give your input. Group 4 Architects made a very wide open and inclusive presentation on May 23 at IBL Middle School. Unfortunately, not too many community members attended. If you favor keeping Sanchez open or oppose a site too close to the ocean, please express your opinion to Group 4. They gathered many suggestions for sites at both ends of the city, and heard what services are important to users. They will gather more information on usage patterns such as who uses each site for what type of activity. They will continue out- reach efforts at the Senior Center, Kops and Kids, Fog Fest, and other community events. The next formal community meeting will be September 28 at the Community Center on Crespi Drive where suggestions will be winnowed and refined. Hope to see you there. Updates will appear on the city"s website under the current projects tab.
