Curbside Pick-Up Available

Since early June curbside pick-up has been available at all SMCL libraries including Sharp Park and Linda Mar libraries. In order to provide maximum safety, contact has been eliminated. Once you browse the catalog at www.smcl.org and place an order, an email will be sent to let you know your item is ready. Then you go to www.smcl.org/curbside-pickup to make an appointment to pick up your item. Appointment hours are 3 to 7 pm on Tuesdays and 10 am to 2 pm on Thursdays and Saturdays. You will find your item bagged and on a table outside the library.

Although the Summer Learning Challenge this year will not have the usual performances, the challenge goes on. The PFOL contributed funds for the purchase of books to be given away to local children. Adjacent to the curbside table there is a table of books for children to choose 2 to take home. No appointment necessary.
