Message from the Co-Presidents

We hope this message finds you well and your eardrums recovered from the 4th of July...Our libraries are reopening cautiously now that COVID cases are greatly reduced. Library hours have been gradually increasing. Check the library website (www.smcl.org.) for the specific hours. Our volunteers are again being allowed into the library on a strictly limited basis. We will work with library staff to get more information about how we can access our books. We are still unable to accept book donations.

Phase 4 of the library reopening will begin in August. The libraries will be open Monday-Saturday; hours will depend on the availability of staff. Staff is preparing both libraries to handle the increase in number of patrons safely.

Here are some other milestones coming up soon.

- Curbside and Walk-up hours will continue.

- The Library is partnering with the city's Park, Beach, and Recreation Dept. to work with Pacifica children this summer.


