The Pacifica Planning Commission has approved construction of a new canopy and kiosk for self-service at Sanchez Library. This new kiosk will enable seven-day service at Sanchez. Patrons will be able to place and pick up holds 24/7. This is part of the Library's effort to increase services to the public in times of COVID and restricted budgets. Construction is slated to start in January.

In mid-October SMC libraries introduced "Power Up Afternoons". This program will enrich and activate after-school experiences for K-12 students. Power Up Afternoons offers the opportunity for

school aged children to connect and make friends while activating creativity, innovation, and learning. Experiences may center on mental wellness, art and self-expression, STEAM, and lifting up the many voices and perspectives in our communities. These programs will be available after school every day at Sharp Park and on open days at Sanchez. You can pick up a flyer that has all the events and times at either library. Wednesdays have an earlier start time due to early release. There will be a special guest once every month.


