Hello Friends,

July marks the beginning of a new fiscal year for us. Here are some of the highlights of the past year as well as some things that are scheduled for the future.

- We elected officers at our June board meeting.
- Our June book sale was a success, raising just under \$2900.
- We are helping support the Dolly Parton Imagination Library. Pacifica has 450 families enrolled. SMCL has the 5<sup>th</sup> largest enrollment in the USA.
- We are helping support the Summer Adventure Program which began on June 1 and goes until August 31. Pick up a log at the library.
- The Pacifica Libraries are sponsoring the Big Lift Inspiring Summer Program this year for the first time.
