### The Big Lift Comes to Pacifica

For the first time, Pacifica will be hosting the Big Lift Inspiring Summer Program (BLIS). For the past decade, BLIS has helped young learners (K -3rs graders) across San Mateo Co. stay engaged during the summer break, build literacy skills, and make meaningful school connections-all while having fun. It is a free 5 week program that will take place at Ocean Shore School and serve 70 students. The students will begin their day with instruction from a credentialed teacher and in the afternoon participate in STEM activities provided by library staff. This county-wide program involves the participation of several agencies including the San Mateo Co. Office of Education, The S.M.Co Libraries, the Pacifica School Dist. and the S.M. Co. Human Services Agency.

## YES! VOLUNTEERING IS THIS MUCH FUN!

Naomi is a long time volunteer and participates in our monthly meetings as a member-at-large with Pacifica Friends of the Library (PFOL). A retired Kindergarten Teacher, Naomi recognizes many of the donated children's books and has taken over setting up our extensive children's corner for the book sales.

We would love to have you join us at our volunteer activities and monthly meetings and have as much fun as Naomi does.

If you have 2-3 hours a month, consider joining our other volunteers maintaining our **Book Nook at Sharp Park Library**. Duties include: emptying the Donation Box, sorting books according to the Book Nook guidelines, placing them in their proper bins in the book storage room, determine which books from the storage room should go to the Book Nook for sale to the public. We will provide training. It's easy and fun, we promise!

Volunteer to help at our twice yearly **Book Sales in June** and **December,** with an occasional pop-up sale during the year. Before the sale we prepare the tables with signage and place books on the proper table. During the sale we tidy the tables, help customers find what they are looking for, total up customer sales, and act as cashier. After the sale we pack up the unsold books and put in the storage room and take down the tables. Set-up and take-down take approximately two to two and a half hours.

**All proceeds help fund programs at both libraries**. With budget cuts looming, we would be grateful for your gift of time to help keep our libraries programs from being affected.
