



BOOK DONATIONS GUIDELINES

Book donations can be left in the book bin in the lobby of the Sharp Park Library. If you have too many books (over 1-2 bags), you can bring them to the Community Room of the Sharp Park Library on the first and third Fridays of the month from 2:30 – 3:30pm. Please go to the website www.pfol94044.org to confirm that you are coming so someone will be available to take them. Books should be clean and in good condition, with covers in condition that would tempt YOU to buy them. Limit 2 boxes per donation.

1. Fiction books should be less than 10 years old unless the book is a classic or collectible.
2. Art books, coffee table books or books that are unique or collectible, including boxed sets.
3. Non-fiction books of all kinds in good condition

WE DO NOT ACCEPT

4. Books in poor condition: This includes
 - Mildewed, moldy, smelly, water damaged, badly worn, or yellowed items.
 - Books with significant highlighting, underlining, or notes
 - Children's books that are marked with someone's child art work.
5. Reference books over 3 years old
6. Encyclopedia sets
7. Legal statutes and casebooks
8. Travel guides over 5 years old
9. Magazines, professional journals, catalogs, or directories.
10. Home- burned cd's, or dvd's
11. Tax preparation guide books
12. Books published by Readers Digest or Bottom Line
13. Zagat guides over 1 year old.
14. Textbooks particularly nursing or science.

Thank you for your cooperation in following these guidelines that greatly help us in managing our donations. We have a very small storage space that we have to manage creatively. We re-sell your books at low prices to benefit the library at our semi-annual book sales.

If the box is full, or you have a large donation, please, **Do Not Leave on the floor.**
